*Saint-Emilion, Premier Grand Cru Classé « A »*

<i>Managing directors</i>	Stéphanie de Boüard-Rivoal and Thierry Grenié de Boüard
<i>Surface area</i>	27 hectares (67 acres)
<i>Location</i>	South-facing slope of Saint-Emilion on the famous foot of the slope
<i>Soils</i>	Clay-limestone on the higher part Clay-sand-limestone on the side of the slope
<i>Density of plantation</i>	6,500 to 8,500 vines per hectare
<i>Grape composition</i>	53% Merlot, 46% Cabernet Franc, 1% Petit Verdot
<i>Average age of the vines</i>	38 years
<i>Pruning technique</i>	Adapted to each vine
<i>Winemaker and œnologist</i>	Hubert de Boüard de Laforest
<i>Technical manager and œnologist</i>	Emmanuelle d'Aligny-Fulchi
<i>Fermentation</i>	In stainless steel, concrete and oak vats
<i>Transfer to barrels</i>	Immediately after running the wine off the skins
<i>Ageing</i>	18 to 22 months in new barrels and foudres
